



OPDS:

Open Publication and Distribution System

- OPDS Specification
 - The Open Publication Distribution System (OPDS)
 Catalog is a syndication format for electronic publications based on Atom RFC4287 and HTTP RFC2616.
 - Catalogs enable the aggregation, distribution, discovery, and acquisition of electronic publications.
 - OPDS Catalogs use existing or emergent open standards and conventions, with a priority on simplicity.



Book Server

- Book Server = OPDS Server
- Repository
 - Add books, along with title, author, language, description, etc.
 - Serve
 - Atom-based OPDS feed (XML)
 - HTTP-based web pages that allow searching, listing, download, etc.



- Creates a website for managing and accessing books
- Allows you to add books + metadata on books
- Catalog allows for listing
- Search feature
- OPDS Feed, which is Atom (XML) based.
- Books are served books via HTTP to:



- Based on OPDS




